Apple App Store and Google Play – Book of Common Prayer: Daily Office Readings by Logos Creative LLC
*This free app is based on the Daily Office Lectionary found in the American version of the Book of Common Prayer. These readings are the same as are found in the Canadian Book of Alternative Services. It is a very simple app to use. Full text of the Scripture readings for each day are provided from the English Standard Version, and the app can read them aloud to you if you wish! This tool will take you through the Bible in a two-year period and through the Psalms about once every seven weeks. Use these readings on their own or in conjunction with the Morning and Evening Prayer services found in the Book of Alternative Services.
