h. Vacant Lot: We have started the process for the rezoning of the 11th Street properties to allow our vacant lot to be used to alleviate some of the parking issues in the downtown. In the meantime we are looking into signage as people are parking illegally right now and our Insurance Company is concerned over possible liability issues.

i. Donation Received:

A \$500.00 donation was received from the ACW Evening Group with the following message: "Thank you for all your hard work. We hope this gift will help your group continue the work you do so well. St. Augustine's ACW Evening Group." Carol will send a thank you note. The idea was put forth that we could give it for use in the Sunday School, possibly for curriculum. A final decision to be made at a later

date.

i. 1. Choir Stoles: Carol introduced the idea of sewing choir stoles using African fabric in recognition of the contribution that our African brothers and sisters continue to make to St. Augustine's. Moved by Don/Seconded by Michael that an amount not to exceed \$500.00 from the Memorial Fund be used to purchase African fabric to make stoles for the choir.
